

Copyright for “The Teaching of Buddha (TTOB)”

Bukkyo Dendo Kyokai (hereafter BDK) as the author/publisher of “The Teaching of Buddha (TTOB)” hopes that as many people as possible in the world can obtain copies of TTOB in Japanese and other languages through printed books and electronic versions. Using TTOB beyond personal use must follow the Japanese Copyright Law such as the Right to Integrity and the other articles listed below.

Right to Integrity

BDK has the right to preserve the integrity of “The Teaching of Buddha (TTOB)” and its title, and is not to be made to suffer any alteration, cuts, translations into other languages or other modifications that are contrary to the author’s intention.

Quotation

You must follow Article 32 of Japanese Copyright Law.

- (1) Citation Purpose must be for education, academic materials, temple newsletters, etc.
- (2) Subordinate-Superior Relationships: Quotations from TTOB must be less than three-pages long and should comprise a low percentage of the entire publication.
- (3) Clear Distinction: Quotations must be clearly distinguished within a new publication (e.g. using quotation marks such as 「」 “” or changing font styles, etc.)
- (4) Attribution of Source Example: “The fragrance of a flower does not float against the wind; but the honor of a good man goes even against the wind into the world.” (“The Teaching of Buddha,” p366, Bukkyo Dendo Kyokai)

Contact BDK if you intend to do the following:

- (1) Use TTOB for sales purposes
- (2) Use quotations not listed above
- (3) Anyone from temples who wishes to quote any passage from TTOB online must contact BDK before actually uploading
